Dr. Michael Pittman – University of Hong Kong, Hong Kong SAR.

Dr. Michael Pittman is the Head of the University of Hong Kong's Vertebrate Paleontology Laboratory in the Department of Earth Sciences. He works on how dinosaurs and other vertebrates move as well as the evolutionary origins of birds, especially their closest relatives the raptors (dromaeosaurids).

Dr. Pittman is a long-term collaborator of Prof. Xu Xing and has a field-based research project with him in the Gobi desert which has unearthed amazing finds such as Linheraptor and Linhenykus.

Dr. Xu Xing – Chinese Academy of Sciences, Beijing, PRC.

Prof. Xu Xing is a World leading dinosaur paleontologist at the Institute of Vertebrate Paleontology and Paleoanthropology (IVPP) of the Chinese Academy of Sciences in Beijing. He has discovered over 50 dinosaur species and is especially well-known for his work on carnivorous dinosaurs -particularly those closely related to birds - as well as his research on the evolution of feathers. Prof. Xu has long-term fieldwork projects in Xinjiang and Inner Mongolia, China.
